Category A: Display of Potted Chrysanthemum & Cut Flowers

Group I
Section I **Potted plants of Chrysanthemum**
Display maximum varieties of potted chrysanthemum within an area of 10'×10'.

Group II
Section I **Cut flowers of Chrysanthemum**
Display of 6 different color blooms of maximum classes of chrysanthemum.

Category B: Category B: Chrysanthemum Floral Arrangement

Group I
Section I **Fresh flower arrangements using Chrysanthemum**
Arrange a basket of flowers using maximum different varieties/colors of chrysanthemum

Section I Make an artistic arrangement of fresh flowers using chrysanthemum reflecting the theme of “**Autumn is awesome than Spring**”. You can use fresh flowers and leaves in any style. Accessories are allowed.

Group II
Section I **Dry flower arrangement**
Make an arrangement with dry flower and other dry natural material based on **any verse of renown poet Parveen Shakir (Late)**. Supporting materials are allowed except paint & varnish. Verse should also be quoted with arrangement.

Category C: Special Displays

Group I Display of Hardscape Elements, e.g.; lights, fountains, planters, pots, benches etc.) in any shape, size and material. (Plants can also be used along with these elements).

Group II Display of anything not mentioned above with the permission of the convener/secretary. Management can/cannot appreciate the participants in any way considering.

Rules and Regulations

- i. Exhibits must be the property of the Exhibitor or entered in the name of the owner of the garden from which they come. Borrowed plants/exhibits from any one are not allowed.
- ii. Exhibits not in accordance with the schedule should be disqualified.
- iii. Decisions of the management committee shall be final. Appeals, if any, may be dishonored/ rejected. Appeals can be made to the convener of the flower show management committee within one hour of the announcement of results.
- iv. Insolence and indiscipline by any exhibitor render him liable for disqualification. At the time when judgment is in progress, no exhibitor or his representative is permitted in the area of the displays of the show and failure to abide that rule may result in the exhibitor to be penalized.
- v. The organizing committee may alter or cancel this event. In that case, no exhibitors shall have any claim against the organizing committee. This change or cancellation in the program may be announced during or before the event. Other means of publicity, if feasible, may also be utilized for making such announcements.
- vi. Participants must collect their exhibits within two days after the closing of the event; otherwise, management/organizing committee will NOT be responsible for any loss.
